**Minutes of Meeting, 6 January 2016**

The meeting was held at the Forney Transportation Museum, 4303 Brighton Blvd., Denver, Colorado.

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 pm by President Dick Thompson. Officers in attendance were Dick Thompson, president; Samantha Baker, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President; Dick Fritz, secretary; and Tom Kay, treasurer. 34 member clubs were represented. Guests and new representatives were introduced.

**Legislation:** Leo Boyle reported that the Colorado Legislature will convene on Wednesday, January 13.

**Political Action Committee (PAC):** Leo presented information about proposed formation of a PAC to improve the CCCC effectiveness and influence at the Colorado Legislature. A summary of Leo's proposal is to be included with these minutes.

**Minutes** of the December 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting were corrected to note that the report of the theft of a trailer and a Mustang was from Bob Bettinger. As corrected, the minutes were approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Tom Kay submitted balances as of the end of December 2015:

Operating Account:	\$ -907.63
Govt.Relations Account:	\$ -6369.60
Havana Cruise:	\$ 6291.25
Colfax Cruise:	\$ 1029.25
Total, 2015 Accounts:	\$ 43.27
Reserve:	\$ 24796.03
Total:	\$ 24839.30

A negative final balance of 2015 Accounts was expected but the Colfax Cruise account received \$839.25 from the FireFighters Museum and the Government Relations Account received \$160 from the dissolution of the High Country Chevy Club. The Operating, Govt.Relations, and Cruise accounts all reset to zero on January 1<sup>st</sup> and the Reserve resets to \$24839.30. The treasurer's report was unanimously approved.

An alternative to the way income tax is reported (Form 990) was suggested; this will be studied.

**Renewals for 2016:** Renewal forms for 2016 are to be mailed out with these minutes, and clubs are urged to use these forms rather than forms from previous years (check the year). In particular, renewal forms on the web site may read 2014, which has incorrect numbers. Dues for clubs are still \$50.00 and the assessment is \$4.00 per membership, based on the

club roles as of the end of the previous fiscal year. A couple is one membership. Associate membership is \$100 and individual membership is \$20.

**CCCC Committees:** Dick Thompson asked for support from clubs and representatives to volunteer on the various committees. A summary of the committees is included as an addendum to these minutes. We can always use more volunteers.

**SEMA (Specialty Equipment Market Association):** SEMA as an organization is very effective in promoting automotive aftermarket manufacturers and also in monitoring nationwide legislation that can affect the car hobby. CCCC is an associate member of SEMA and individuals are urged to become members of the SEMA Action Network (SEMA SAN) in order to receive email updates on industry developments and legislative alerts. There is no cost to join; the link to use is [SAN@SEMA.ORG](mailto:SAN@SEMA.ORG). Members of CCCC who are members of SEMA/SAN are eligible (not automatically authorized) to attend the SEMA Show in Las Vegas in November.

This is to be the annual **Presidents Night**, and all club chief officers are invited to attend. There will be pizza and soft drinks provided.
